Information about Quaich Badminton Competition

What is it?

These are competitions for school teams consisting of 4/5 boys and 4/5 girls. Areas throughout Scotland run competitions to find their local champions who then go forward to the national finals to find the "top school" in Scotland.

What constitutes a team?

A minimum of 8 and a maximum of 10 players (per team) with an equal **gender split** of 4/5 boys and 4/5 girls. If schools wish to enter more than one team in the event please contact Joan as this may be possible depending on the number of entries.

What is the format?

- A match consists of Boys Singles, Girls Singles, Boys Doubles, Girls Doubles, Mixed Doubles
- Games are played to 21 points no setting

(NB: Team members can only play once in each match. Teams members and playing order can be changed for each match)

Entry Fee

The entry fee for the local competition is \pounds 40.00 per team to be collected by team managers and paid on entry with the entry form or can be paid by prior agreement on the day – to arrange contact Joan. **Cheques made payable to Aberdeenshire Council.**

Affiliation

Schools must be affiliated to Scottish Schools Badminton Union by the competition date.

North East Area

Refers to the area of Aberdeenshire and Aberdeen City. SSBU affiliated schools in both these local authority areas can enter if they have a team made up of the correct combination of players
