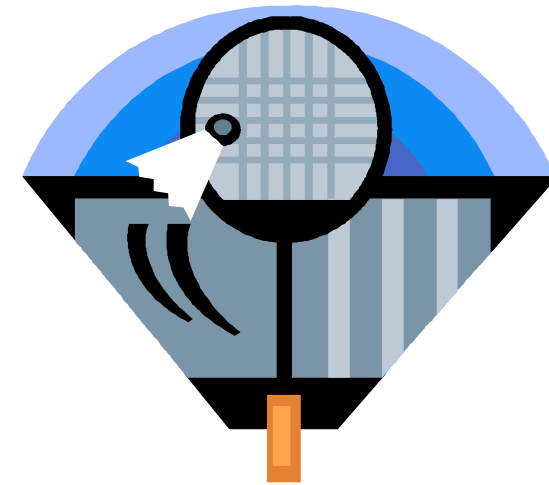

Doubles: Pairs can be either mixed or same gender but must be from same school.

Format Early stages will be run on a pool basis with no setting. There will be trophies for the winners and runners up and the points gained by each pupil in their first games will be added together to give an average school total. The winning rural and large primary school will each receive a shield. Individual winners and runners up will receive a trophy. All competitors will receive a certificate.
