HIDDEN GEMS

A half-mile from Whitehills, on the east side of the village, there stands a very ancient building called the Red Well. It derives its name from a spring of water which leaves a red deposit, possibly with an iron content. The Romans built the beehive shaped house, which protects the spring.

Whitehills to Cullen coast walk is 12.6 miles and passes Portsoy and Sandend., Findlater Castle

The Banff to Whitehills coast walk is around 5 miles and is a relatively flat walk with beautiful scenery
