HIDDEN GEMS

The Knaps of Downies separate Cammachmore Bay from Downies Haven. They are a series of mounds that run seaward from west to east. Puffins nest there and dolphins can be seen if they are in the area. It is also a good viewing area to look north, east and south from. There is a path that leads across the ridge of the Knaps however care should be taken because there is a precipitous drop of about 80 – 100 feet on the northern side.
