HIDDEN GEMS

A walk to Dess Waterfall at Kincardine O'Neil mixes open farmland with mature pine forest. There are good views over Strathdee towards Banchory.

Aboyne stone circle is a little-known stone circle that stands in an oak wood in Aboyne. Park in the cemetery car park and walk up the path through the woods. When the wooded area gives way to field the stone circle is a couple hundred metres on a path to your left.
